"It Is Advent, Not Yet Christmas"

The word Advent comes from the Latin word *adventus* and Greek word *parousia*. The meaning of the word Advent is "coming". All too many people see Advent as the preparatory season for Christmas which is not actually true. It is the preparatory season for the celebration of the Incarnation. In the earliest days of Christianity, Advent was seen as "a little Lent" in that it was a season of repentance in preparation for the celebration of the Incarnation. The Christmas season begins with Christmas Day and continues through the Feast of the Epiphany (the 12 days of Christmas). In the church we follow that with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord as we mark the beginning of His ministry.

Why is this important to know?

If we will treat Advent as a season of reconciliation, cleaning our hearts of all that is impure, then we can truly celebrate the joy of the Incarnation as we too are filled with the presence and divine love of Jesus Christ. If your glass is full, there is no room for more, but if we will empty ourselves of our own selfish desires, Jesus Christ will fill us with Hope, Peace, Joy and Love.

May our Advent truly prepare us to receive the greatest gift known to humanity in the Incarnation of Jesus Christ our Lord.


