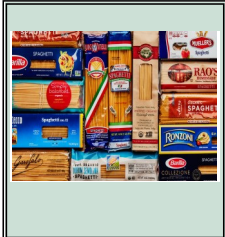
Come along and join me in this season of evaluation and let us celebrate the conclusion of this year and open the door to the joys and celebrations of another.

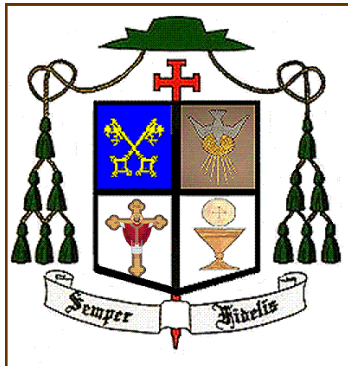
